Alliance Health is making the following recommendations for the 2026 QAP.

- 1) Separate fully accessible units and visual and hearing impaired units, because these unit types are currently overlapping. The preference is the visual and hearing impaired units meet the requirements to be built into type B units to preserve fully accessible units. We believe these upgrades could be achieved through a reasonable modification, rather than requiring fully accessible, wheelchair-accessible roll-in showers.
- 2) We are asking for HFA to increase 1-bedroom unit production at each development.
- 3) Increase in fully accessible wheelchair accessible roll-in shower units from 5% to 10% (ref (F)(3)) section in QAP.
