For those unaware, the State Tax Credit will sunset on December 31, 2014 and not be available to future projects beginning in 2015. The proposed Senate and House budgets (SB744) both include a \$10,000,000 appropriation titled the Workforce Housing Loan Program (WHLP). While the budget has not yet been approved by the legislature, we wanted to make you aware of the proposed WHLP language for comments.

In addition to comments on the WHLP and other suggested revisions, we are also seeking comments on what you considered to have worked well in the 2014 cycle. Letting us know what worked is just as important as letting us know what did not.
