RE: 2020 QAP 2nd Draft Comments

Dear Mr. Farmer,

Thanks again for the continued opportunity to comment regarding the 2020 QAP. We certainly understand crafting a QAP isn't easy as NCHFA delicately balances input from numerous stakeholders to reach the end goal of facilitating high quality affordable housing for working class North Carolinians. As such, we feel particularly moved to make the following point:

1. <u>Tiebreaker Criteria – First Tiebreaker:</u> The project in the census tract with the lowest percentage of families below the poverty rate.

We strongly believe NCHFA should maintain the first tie breaker as the lowest percentage of families below the poverty rate. First, doing so allows NCHFA to favor development in amenity rich opportunity areas. Such areas tend to not only have better schools for families, but also greater access to decent paying jobs. Second, this also helps the agency deconcentrate poverty. Section 42 allows for developments in a Qualified Census Tract to receive the basis boost which for decades has led to the concentration of poverty. In response to this, we have seen nearly all of the 15 states we work in over the last decade incentivize areas of opportunity which we believe is good public policy. Thus, we recommend NCHFA keep the first tiebreaker as the lowest percentage of families below the poverty rate as currently included in the Second Draft QAP.
