Since working with adults with different physical abilities over the past eleven years, one thing has remained consistent and that is the shortage of adequate housing in North Carolina. Assisting with transitioning North Carolinans from institutions to community living I have had a front seat to observe how the lack of accessible housing has prevented or delayed transitions. A 2018 report from Money Follows the Person, a NC Medicaid transitions program, revealed that satisfaction with living arrangements improved quality of life by 45% over the pre-transition baseline. I am asking that you strongly consider and implement an increase from the 5% of fully accessible units to 10%.
